Creating a Quiz

- 1. Go to your course in Canvas.
- 2. Select **Quizzes** from the left-hand menu.
- 3. Select + **Quiz** in the upper right corner.
- 4. Add a quiz name and relevant instructions.

Quiz Type: Graded Quiz is the default setting, and the most common one. You may want to use a Practice Quiz (does not affect grades) or a Survey (no correct answers, based on completion).

Assignment Group: If you already have groups set up, you can add the quiz to one. **Time Limit:** The time the students have to answer the quiz questions, once they've opened the quiz. This time must be shorter than the availability window.

- 5. Uncheck Allow Multiple Attempts and Let Students See Their Quiz Responses.
- 6. Add an availability window and a due date. The <u>availability window must be longer than</u> <u>the time limit</u>, if the quiz is timed.
- 7. Select **Questions** from the top menu.
- 8. Select + New Question.
- 9. Add a question name and the content of the question to the text editors.

You can also select other answer options: for instance, essay (free response) answers. If you choose a different answer type, skip to Step 12.

- 10. Add your answer choices (Canvas does not use letters to denote the questions, so don't include letter choices in your answers, e.g. "Both A and B").
- 11. Set the correct answer choice by selecting the green arrow next to it.
- 12. Select Update Question.
- 13. Repeat Steps 8-12 until you have added all of your questions.
- 14. Select **Save** or **Save & Publish** at the bottom of the page.
